## Season Highlights



The absolute highlight of our 30! Anniversary Season was our Are You Hungary? **Discover Brahms Discovery** Concert followed by our 30! **Anniversary Celebration** at Drew University. The concert

featured 45 members of the Orchestra exploring Brahms' Hungarian Dances No. 6 & 11, which were performed at our inaugural concert 30 years ago.

Five musicians that performed with us were also with us at that inaugural concert!

We were happy to welcome, as our concert guests, 40 students and staff of the Paterson Music Project, an El Sistema program based in Paterson, NJ.



The celebration that followed in the Mead Hall mansion featured remarks by the Honorable Thomas Kean, Sr., former NJ governor and passionate advocate for the arts. We were so pleased to honor Judy Musicant & Hugh Clark with our **Discovery Award** for their long-time support, service and generosity.

Our Intimate Afternoon & Evening Recital Series displayed an immense variety—all the way from the beauty of poetry and music paired together to the toe tapping fun of bluegrass with the **Todd Collins Stringband** in a restored barn! In between we were entertained by the incredible a cappella group the **GrooveBarbers** at *Discover* Holiday Song, and were mesmerized by Mike Truesdell at Discover the Vibraphone.

Fall in Love with Music, our eight-part series for American Public Television, was broadcast over 1100 times in major markets across the US. The potential audience for those 1100 broadcasts? Over 66 million!



**Dueling Pianists** made a return appearance at our February Discovery Concert at Drew featuring the virtuosity of pianists Ko-Eun Yi and Daniel Hsu.

The fall Discovery Concert, Discover Mendelssohn, featured two string

quartets—the Aeolus and the American—performing Mendelssohn's Octet for Strings.

As part of our Outreach efforts, Maestro Maull provided music listening programs at the Willow School and for the aspiring, young musicians at the **Paterson Music Project** and **Newark Boys Chorus School.** Thanks to the generosity of a grant by the Ernst Wessel Foundation, Maestro Maull shared music listening lectures at the Warren Public Library and Warrenbrook Seniors, as well as for the residents at The Chelsea at Warren

## Leadership Message WHERE DOES THE TIME GO!

Memories from the founding of the Philharmonic Orchestra of New Jersey 30 years ago seem like events that happened only yesterday. 'Dog and pony shows' for prospective benefactors, envisioning and staging the first Viennese Ball, rave reviews of concerts that appeared in print newspapers, and those 80's hairstyles are just a few!

Our evolution to The Discovery Orchestra has been amazing to contemplate. We are very proud to have carved out our unique music listening education niche locally and nationally. And that singular achievement was made possible only through the vision and dedication of the many people who have accompanied us on our journey. Staff members, trustees, benefactors, musicians, educational and media partners, volunteers and our audiences, have all shaped and nurtured us through the past three decades.

We were so pleased to celebrate this milestone in special ways including: a retrospective video, the festive 30th Anniversary Gala with Honorary Chair, former New Jersey Governor Tom Kean, Sr. and the many celebratory blogs and photos posted on social media throughout the season. Additionally, we produced our signature Discovery programs for New Jersey audiences at Drew University's Concert Hall, private homes, the Visual Arts Center of New Jersey, the NJ Youth Symphony Music Center and at schools and community centers. Episodes of our eight-part series for American Public Television, Fall in Love with Music, were broadcast more than 1,100 times on stations nationwide and reached even more viewers via Films Media Group and Amazon Internet streaming.

What's next for The Discovery Orchestra? We will continue thinking creatively about how to reach the most people we can with music listening instruction. This includes our live events, but also our media presence, as well as developing a national reputation as thought leaders in mindfulness regarding music and the arts.

We know that cajoling people to engage with classical music is challenging, but responses like the following from a Fall in Love with Music viewer inspire us to continue this work as we begin our next decade:

"I can enthusiastically say that this series is just what it will take to help convey the joy of listening and loving classical music to the next generation...I'm going to purchase this series for my children to share with their children. You know—it seems that Maestro Maull picks up and continues what Bernstein started in his Young People's Concerts on CBS."



## Our National Campaign for Music Listening— The TASC Group

Starting in January 2017, The Discovery Orchestra began a two-year engagement with the high-end New York City public relations firm, The TASC Group. The focus of our work together is a national music listening campaign that will share the Discovery methodology and Maestro Maull's thought leadership across a much broader audience.

The TASC Group is a boutique firm, providing personalized, hands-on PR and communications services. They represent inspiring and pioneering clients in social justice and advocacy, human rights, public and higher education, healthcare, life sciences, the arts, celebrity advocacy and more.

Our work with TASC through 6/30/17 has raised the Orchestra's profile and brand, and built a critical platform through which we are expanding our visibility on a regional and national stage. Highlights from our first six months included:

- 2 radio interviews with Maestro Maull on WBJC Classical in Baltimore and KJZZ/NPR in Phoenix
- A feature article in *Insider Louisville*, reaching nearly 25,000 readers
- A feature article in both the print and online versions of *The Star-Ledger* about our 30th Anniversary and current programs

Going forward the focus will be on partnering with other thought leaders in the areas of arts education, mindfulness and the joys of active music listening, through blogs, additional features, media interviews and lectures at respected regional institutions. More to come!


