B **2.** B's two strong **UNISONS** begin "chase"



B repeats not quite literally

? **3.** "Half" of \_\_\_\_ returns... beginning in the middle

C **4.** "Zany" *C Part 1* presented *and* repeated



5. C Part 2 presented and repeated



A 6. A Section makes anticipated comeback and repeats not literally



D 7. D Part 1... the grand gesture of the Csárdás with repeat



8. D Part 2 presents new musical idea – then reverts to Part 1... and repeats



## E 9. Sensual E Part 1 VIOLA & CELLO begin – VIOLIN has MELODY in repeat



- **10.** *E Part 2* \_\_\_\_\_\_ takes momentary lead but **STRINGS** return with *Part 1* No. 10 then \_\_\_\_\_
- ? **11.** "Zany" \_\_\_ comes back!
  - **12.** *C* with a "new twist!" What's new?
- D 13. The *Csárdás* returns.
- B **14.** *B* returns with its strong **UNISONS** and repeats
- A 15. The A REFRAIN appears before a SOLO \_\_\_\_\_ CADENZA

E 16. STRINGS alone play introspective idea based on E



C **17.** "Zany" *C* makes briefest appearance



- ? 18. STRETTO and SEQUENCE based on \_\_\_\_\_ increase tension
  - **19. TEMPO** increases to breaking point as C and D are combined

A **20.** A "one more time" as Brahms pushes to breathless conclusion!

### A SECTION

1. Song-like THEME 1 Part 1 in F MINOR



2. THEME 1 Part 2 in A-FLAT MAJOR this happens \_\_\_ times



3. Beautiful **HARMONIES** bring us back to \_\_\_\_\_ \_\_ \_\_\_



4. THEME 1 Part 3 in F MINOR "concluding thoughts"



5. A favorite **CHORD PROGRESSION** as music winds down



**6.** Short **TRANSITION...** listen carefully



#### **B SECTION**

7. THEME 2 Part 1 in D-FLAT MAJOR hints of pomp and triumph



THEME 2 PART 1 repeats \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_

8. THEME 2 Part 2



THEME 2 Part 2 repeats identically

9. THEME 2 Part 3 turns suddenly strident



Two pair identical measures lead to **CONTRARY MOTION** 

10. Landing on 1/2 DIMINISHED 7th CHORD begins RECITATIVE



A 11. Song-like THEME 1 Part 1... listen for subtle changes!



**12. THEME 1 Part 2...** ditto!




13. Beautiful HARMONIES again bring us back to THEME 1 Part 1



14. THEME 1 Part 3 in F MINOR "concluding thoughts"



15. Measure with favorite CHORD PROGRESSION played \_\_\_\_ times



CODA **16. CODA** (extra ending) *sounds* as if the \_\_\_\_ **SECTION** will return



17. And B SECTION does briefly reappear



**18.** But... **THEME 2 part 2** now "shadow of itself"... gets slower


