LEADERSHIP MESSAGE

Dear Friends of The Discovery Orchestra:

Fiscal Year 2024 was the final year of our three-year Strategic Plan, which emphasized deepening our engagement with current patrons, reaching new audiences, and generating the necessary financial investment to support these initiatives. The year provided an exciting opportunity to build on past success through the implementation of new programming, live events, and increased media presence.

Our 37th Season featured enthusiastic receptions of our public television shows, online content, and live programs. In the fall of 2023, we launched our AHA! Classical game app, followed by the premiere screening of a new short-form video: Discover Mozart: Variations on a Familiar Tune. We also presented an Intimate Afternoon in December featuring a holiday-themed harp program. Bi-monthly broadcasts of Inside Music on WWFM—The Classical Network ran throughout the season, including a special live-performance broadcast of Jessie Montgomery's Strum in February.

As of January 2024, four of our educational television programs were in simultaneous national distribution—a first for us—through American Public Television, and they were also streamed on PBS Passport and Amazon Prime Video. The reach of our live community engagement sessions provided to local partners increased this season, as we provided listening sessions for students and seniors in five New Jersey counties. And the Borealis Wind Quintet "wowed" us with their performances as part of our *Vive la France!* Patrons' Dinner Gala in April.

Thank you for your continued belief in our mission—and for being part of our Discovery Orchestra family. As this Impact Report will demonstrate, your support is indeed making a difference!





FINANCIAL SNAPSHOT



The small negative change in net assets in FY24 was due to a planned promotion campaign for the Discover Saint-Saens' "Organ" Symphony television show and game app development with Social Impact Studios.

The FY23 Other Revenue includes \$93,509 of Employee Retention Credit funds.

The negative change in net assets in FY23 was due to the planned release of \$314,223 of restricted funds received in prior seasons. These funds were dedicated to cover production and distribution expenses for the Discover Saint-Saens' "Organ" Symphony public television program as well as some costs of our promotion campaign and game app development with Social Impact Studios.
